




13 Brothers and sisters, we do not want you to be uninformed about those who sleep in death, so that you do not grieve like the rest of mankind, who have no hope. 14 For we believe that Jesus died and rose again, and so we believe that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him.

<sup>15</sup> According to the Lord's word, we tell you that we who are still alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will certainly not precede those who have fallen asleep. <sup>16</sup> For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.

<sup>17</sup> After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever. <sup>18</sup> Therefore encourage one another with these words.



#### What would C1 Jews have understood by 'the clouds'?

`Be-a-nan' The most frequent of the 4 OT words translated as cloud(s)

"cloud": 107 times in 94 verses, "clouds" 49 times in 49 verses, "cloudy" 6 times in 6 verses

#### Clouds can be more than a metrological phenomenon:

Carriers of God's promise (the rainbow) Gen 9.13

The guidance of God, and a **symbol of the presence of God** (the pillar of cloud) Ex 13.21 "The Lord went ahead of them in a pillar of cloud..."

#### What would C1 Jews have understood by 'the clouds'?

#### **Definition of Shechinah** ..... the presence of God in Jewish theology

- \* Jehovah came down upon Sinai in a cloud (Exodus 19:9)
- \* The cloud filled the court around the tabernacle in the wilderness so that Moses could not enter it (Exodus 40:34-5)
- \* At the dedication of the temple also the cloud "filled the house of the Lord" ( 1 Kings

What would C1 Jews have understood by 'the clouds'?

#### The Shechinah the presence of God

A theological understanding rather than a metrological understanding

aera

What would C1 Jews/Greeks have understood by 'the air'


"The aeroplane is flying through the air at 30,000 feet"

"I am breathing air here whilst I am sitting in this room "

#### "...to meet the Lord in the air."

COULD mean at 30,000 foot (sky / atmosphere)

COULD equally mean whilst you are sitting in this room i.e. breathing air and 'in the air' rather than 'under the ground' (i.e. dead – in Hades (Greek / Roman ) or Sheol (Jewish) ) continuing the alive/dead thread in verses 13, 14, 15 & 16)


